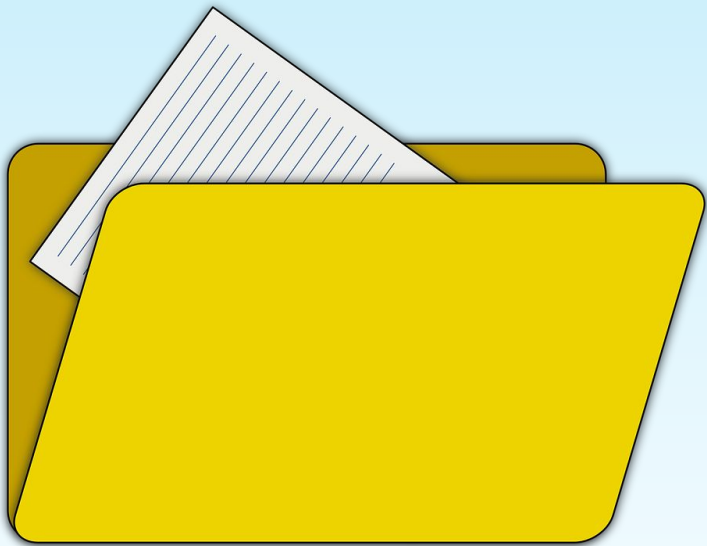
- ★ 20 minutes of daily reading including weekends (100 min)
