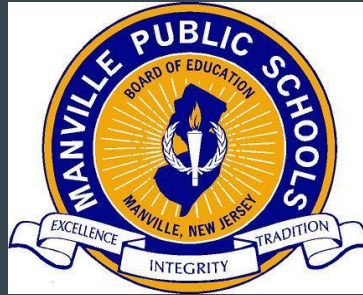

Components of the Safe Return to Instruction Plan

- Maintaining health and safety
- Ensuring Continuity of Services
- Public Comment

Maintaining Health and Safety

- Universal and correct wearing of masks
- Physical Distancing
- Handwashing and Respiratory Etiquette
- Cleaning and maintaining healthy facilities, including ventilation
- Contact tracing in combination with isolation and quarantine, in collaboration with state, local, territorial or tribal health departments
- Diagnostic and screening testing
- Efforts to provide vaccinations to educators, staff and students
- Appropriate accommodations for students with disabilities with respect to health and safety policies

Ensuring Continuity of Services

- Describe how the LEA will ensure continuity of services, including but not limited to services to address students' academic needs and students' and staff social, emotional, mental health, and other needs, which may include student health and food services.
 - Academic needs will be addressed through enhanced tutoring, enrichment and counseling that will begin in the summer and continue through the school year.
 - Additional counselors have been hired and additional hours have been posted for the purpose of delivering essential services to students.
 - Support will be provided to district staff to address their social, emotional and mental health needs.
 - Staff will be provided opportunities for professional development and growth opportunities. Dollars have also been set aside for learning acceleration for the next three years.
 - Manville Borough Schools will continue to provide meals for pickup on a weekly basis for our students.
