I hope this correspondence finds you well and excited to start the 2020/21 school year, scheduled to begin on Tuesday, September 8th, 2020.

As you know, we are starting our year with several options for our students. Grades Prek-5 will have the option of an in-person hybrid model or a fully virtual model. Grades 6-12 will be attending school virtually through the first marking period. Students in PSD, Multiple Disabilities, Behavioral Disabilities, and Language and Learning Disabilities classrooms will have the option of returning to in-person instruction Monday-Thursday every week starting September 8th.
